Corrective Action: Beyel Brothers must label all containers of used oil with the words "Used Oil".

Explanation: Beyel Bros. failed to respond to discharges of used oil.
Corrective Action: Beyel Bros. must stop all discharges of used oil. Impacted soils must be excavated and properly disposed.

 Explanation: Beyel Brothers failed to close and to provide secondary containment for two 5-gallon buckets of used oil.
 Corrective Action: Beyel Brothers must maintain used oil in containers with secondary containment that can hold 110% of the volume of the containers. Beyel Brothers must keep containers of used oil closed.

 Rule: 262.11
 Explanation: A. Beyel Brothers is maintaining many containers of unknown chemicals and materials.
 B. Beyel Brothers deposited spent blast media on the ground.
 Corrective Action: A. Beyel Brothers must complete an inventory of the containers of materials and submit it to the Department.
 B. Beyel Brothers must analyze the spent blast media to include chromium, lead, cadmium, arsenic, barium, and selenium.
